## Sports Center

With a café, an indoor gym, and squash courts, the sports center will offer a place that parents and visitors can use without necessarily accessing the main school campus grounds. It's a sharable space for parents, visitors and students.

## Junior School

Our early years and elementary schools will be housed in this courtyard. The junior school will be built along with the main administration block in Phase 2.

## Dorms & Housing

Overlooking the campus and out to the lake, the dorms and staff housing enjoy a spectacular view. Two four-storied blocks split between the boys and girls will house over 200 students and 8 families.

## Senior School

Both our middle school and high school will be housed in this 34 classroom courtyard complex, which is Phase 1 of construction. With the completion of this phase, our current senior school will shift to the new campus.

## Performing Arts

Our arts center, which is modeled after the Shakespeare Globe Theatre, will accommodate up to 1000 people and offer a unique opportunity for interaction between the performers and the audience

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## Phase One

The plan for Phase One is to build essential school facilities to get the school operational at the Lakeside Campus. These will include all of the middle and high school classrooms, library, specialized classrooms, administration offices, the covered pavilion, changing rooms and dining facilities.
